

**St. Vrain and Left Hand Water Conservancy District
Resolution 2017-04**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ST. VRAIN AND LEFT HAND WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT SUPPORTING BALLOT ISSUE 2J, ON THE NOVEMBER 7, 2017, COORDINATED MUNICIPAL ELECTION BALLOT AND CALLING ON VOTERS WITHIN THE DISTRICT'S BOUNDARIES TO VOTE "YES" ON BALLOT ISSUE 2J.

WHEREAS, provision of adequate water supplies is critical to property owners and individuals and businesses located within the boundaries of the Saint Vrain and Left Hand Water Conservancy District (District); and

WHEREAS, the participation by the City of Longmont in the construction of a reservoir to maximize its existing water rights provides security that is necessary and integral to the current and future water supply of the Saint Vrain and Left Hand basins to meet current and future water supply demands; and

WHEREAS, the construction of a reservoir will also expand the diversity and resiliency of the basins' water supply, assuring the provision of high quality water to support the vitality and health of Basin residents who live in Longmont and other Basin residents who work in or visit Longmont; and

WHEREAS, passage of issue 2J will assist in providing additional water supplies in the Saint Vrain and Left Hand Basins, benefiting all property owners and individuals and businesses located within the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF THE SAINT VRAIN AND LEFT HAND WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT:


Section 1. For the reasons stated above, the Board supports ballot issue 2J.

The Board calls on District property owners and individuals eligible to vote in this Coordinated Municipal Election to vote "YES" on ballot issue 2J for the purpose of helping finance water system improvements, including but not limited to the construction of a water storage reservoir as part of the Windy Gap Firming Project.
